Registration codes

Code	Code summary	Prescribed classes
FMBR	Between farm blocks (not farm implements and farm tractors)	A vehicle owned by a primary producer used in working nominated parcels of land in conjunction with each other (includes boat retrieval by commercial fisherman) defined in Schedule 1 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1959 Regulations.
MSCL	Restricted or limited use	A vehicle restricted to a specified area by conditions or by conditions in accordance with a notice issued by the Registrar.
OL3H	Historic vehicle	A motor vehicle where 30 years or more have elapsed since 1 January of the year in which the vehicle was manufactured and its use restricted to no more than 90 days in each period of 12 months registration, with each journey recorded in a Log Book.
OL3L	Left hand drive vehicle	A vehicle manufactured before 1 January 1974 and its use restricted to no more than 90 days in each period of 12 months registration, with each journey recorded in a Log Book.
OL3G	Historic vehicle plus extension	A motor vehicle where 30 years or more have elapsed since 1 January of the year in which the vehicle was manufactured and its use restricted to no more than 90 days in each period of 12 months registration, with each journey recorded in a Log Book. The vehicle may also be driven (at any time during that period) for a distance not exceeding 500 metres, but only for the purpose of relocating the vehicle from one part of a property to another, or enabling another vehicle to gain access to a road or property.
OL3K	Left hand drive vehicle plus extension	A vehicle manufactured before 1 January 1974 and its use restricted to no more than 90 days in each period of 12 months registration, with each journey recorded in a Log Book. The vehicle may also be driven (at any time during that period) for a distance not exceeding 500 metres, but only for the purpose of relocating the vehicle from one part of a property to another, or enabling another vehicle to gain access to a road or property.

ERV	Emergency response vehicle	A vehicle defined as an ambulance, fire fighting vehicle, or rescue vehicle within the Motor Vehicles Act, 1959 Regulations.
SPV	Special purpose vehicle	A vehicle that is not constructed for the carriage of loads or passengers and whose primary purpose on the road network is not the carriage of loads or passengers. (Vehicles include forklifts, tractors, self propelled farm implements, front end loaders, mobile cranes, bulldozers, etc.)

CTBA	Conditions to be assessed	Must comply with Road Traffic Act but registration effected subject to assessment of conditions by the Transport SA - Road Transport Assessment and Safety Group.
GO - General Operation		
GO 1	No towing	Not permitted to tow any other vehicle or trailer.
GO 2	Pilot vehicle required	Pilot vehicle to accompany vehicle when travelling on any road.
GO 3	Observer required	Observer required to travel in the vehicle with the driver.
GO 4	Police escort required	Police escort to accompany vehicle when travelling on any road.
GO 5	Route restriction	Use only when required and by the shortest suitable route between depots and worksites.
GO 6	Crash bars	Crash attenuation fixtures to be maintained on the vehicle.
GO 7	Projections to be covered	Potential or hazardous projections must be covered by rigid material (eg metal cage) when travelling or standing on any road.
GO 8	Unladen travel	Only to be driven on the road when unladen.
GO 9	Transport SA dispensation	Only to be used in accordance with the certificate of exemption or dispensation issued by the Transport SA - Road Transport Assessment and Safety Group.
GO 10	Gazette - Wheelchair Braune Batricar invalid vehicle (Gopher)	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled 'Self Propelled Wheelchairs'.
GO 11	Gazette - Footpath Sweeper Blaw Know	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled 'Footpath Sweepers-Section 61 not to apply'.
GO 12	Gazette - Footpath Sweeper MacDonald	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government

GO 13	Gazette - Footpath Sweeper Johnson Series 2000	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled 'Section 8a-Proclamation of a Specified Class of Vehicle'.
GO 14	Gazette - Power assisted cycles	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled 'Power Assisted Pedal Cycles'.
GO 15	Gazette - Golf cars	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled ' Exemption for Golf Cars Operating on Golf Courses '.
GO 16	Gazette - Left hand drive golf cars	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled 'Notice of Exemption concerning prohibition of Left Hand Drive Golf Cars'.
GO 17	Gazette - 2 wheel motorcycles for agricultural use	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled ' Exemption from Australian Design Rule Requirements for Motor Bikes and Motor Bikes fitted with a Side Car which are being used for Work Related Activities by Primary Producers and Nominated Government Departments and Authorities '.
GO 18	Gazette - 'Jinker' type vehicles	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled 'Exemption to operate Special Purpose 'Jinker Type' vehicles, within the Adelaide Produce Market'.
GO 19	Gazette - 3 or 4 wheel motorcycles for agricultural use	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled ' Exemption from the Road Traffic (Vehicle Standards) Rules 1999, for Three and Four Wheel Motorcycles which are being used for Work Related Activities by Primary Producers and Nominated Government Departments and Authorities '.
GO 20	Gazette - Land yachts use at Port Gawler by the Adelaide Land Yacht Club	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled ' Exemption for Land Yachts '.
GO 21	Gazette - Tractors used for Agricultural Purposes, Self Propelled Agricultural Machines and Agricultural Implements, exemption from Lighting Equipment, Mudguards,	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled ' Exemption for the fitting of Lighting Equipment, Rear Vision Mirrors, Horn and Other Equipment to Agricultural Vehicles which are Not More than 3 metres in Width '.

| LO 3A | Zone restriction | Not permitted to travel in the Adelaide Metropolitan Area. |

LO 5B	Road restriction	Travel is only permitted on a road within a defined (signed) work area or construction zone and the worksite is signed in accordance with Australian Standard 1742.3 - 1985, Part 3 'Traffic Control for Works on Roads' and to be transported by float (not driven) between work sites.

LV - Long Combination Vehicles

LV 1	Permit required	Only to be used in accordance with a Road Train permit issued by Transport SA - Road Transport Assessment and Safety Group.
LV 2	Permit/ Gazette required	Only to be used in accordance with a Road Train permit issued by Transport SA - Road Transport Assessment and Safety Group or the notices published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled ' Operation of Road Train Vehicles in South Australia '.

MV - Medium Combination Vehicles

MV 1	Permit required	Only to be used in accordance with a Medium Combination Vehicle permit issued by Transport SA - Road Transport Assessment and Safety Group.
MV 2	Permit/ Gazette required	Only to be used in accordance with a permit issued by Transport SA - Road Transport Assessment and Safety Group or the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette titled 'Operation of Medium Combination Vehicles' dated 6 July 1996.

OL - Ownership Limitations

OL 1	Ownership not transferable	Ownership cannot be automatically transferred.
OL 2	Ownership restrictions	Conditions only apply while under current ownership.
OL 3	Membership of Club	The registered owner must be a member of an authorised motoring club and the vehicle must only be used in conjunction with an authorised

club event.

OM - Overmass

OM 1	Bridge restriction	Not to be driven over or used on any bridge or culvert.
OM 2	Gazette	Not yet determined.
OM 3	Permit required	Only to be used in accordance with an overmass permit issued by Transport SA - Road Transport Assessment and Safety Group.

OS - Oversize

OS 1	Agricultural Gazette	Only to be used in accordance with the notice published in the South Australian Government Gazette dated 24 October 1996 titled 'Operation of Agricultural Vehicles in South Australia' dated October 1996.
OS 2	Permit required	Only to be used in accordance with an oversize permit issued by Transport SA - Road Transport Assessment and Safety Group.

SL - Signs and Lights (conspicuity)

SL 1	Special lights	Special lamps lit during specified use only ie. when the vehicle is in a hazard position on the road.
SL 1A	Stop & turn signal lamps	For travel between sunrise and sunset only, the vehicle is exempt from the lighting requirements except for stop and turn signal lamps.
SL 2	Special delineation	Special delineation of protrusions by way of lamps, signs, marking boards or reflectors required.
SL 2A	Flags on extremities	Brightly coloured red, yellow, or red and yellow flags each at least 450 mm square shall be attached to the extremities of the vehicle or any projecting part.
SL 3	Delineators required	Delineation of overwidth or overlength extremities such as stripes in contrasting colours.
SL 3A	Delineators required	Delineators shall be attached to the extremities of the vehicle or any projecting part.
SL 3B	Delineators required	Vehicle to be painted white in colour.
SL 4	Special lights	Front, rear and side extremities of the vehicle to be floodlight for travel between sunset and sunrise.
SL 5	Slow vehicle sign	'SLOW VEHICLE' sign to be fitted to the front and rear of the vehicle.
SL 6	Left hand drive sign	'LEFT HAND DRIVE' sign to be fitted to the front and rear of the vehicle.
SL 7	Dual control sign	'DUAL CONTROL' sign to be fitted to the front and rear of the vehicle.

SP - Speed Limited

SP 10 10km/h maximum
SP 15 15km/h maximum
